ADI takes our commitments to environmental sustainability program and combatting climate change seriously, as both core to our business and as part of our responsibility to provide credible and accurate sustainability information for our stakeholders. We are fully committed to achieving net zero by 2050 or sooner.

Our Continued Commitment

ADI registered our net zero commitment with SBTi in 2021. That same year, ADI also acquired Maxim Integrated. Since then, ADI has taken significant steps toward reducing our carbon footprint including advancing our transition to renewable energy, and leveraging our fab expansions to implement state-of-the-art equipment to significantly reduce our emissions. As a larger company, it will take more time to create the credible models and plans required for submission.

Unfortunately, SBTi's policy and deadline for submission of the long-term strategy does not allow flexibility for major company changes. As such, in early March, the Science Based Targets Initiative (SBTi) will mark ADI's status on their webpage as "Commitment Removed."

Despite this change to our SBTi status, our commitment has not waned, and we remain resolute in our commitment to net zero by 2050 or sooner. After the appropriate analysis and modeling, ADI will issue a Net Zero strategy and Climate Transition Plan in line with our publicly stated commitments.
