I. Device Description

A. General

The MAX11600-MAX11605 low-power, 8-bit, multichannel, analog-to-digital converters (ADCs) feature internal track/hold (T/H), voltage reference, clock, and an I2C-compatible 2-wire serial interface. These devices operate from a single supply and require only 350µA at the maximum sampling rate of 188ksps. AutoShutdown(TM) powers down the devices between conversions, reducing supply current to less than 1µA at low throughput rates. The MAX11600/MAX11601 provide 4 analog input channels each, the MAX11602/MAX11603 provide 8 analog input channels each while the MAX11604/MAX11605 provide 12 analog input channels. The analog inputs are software configurable for unipolar or bipolar and single-ended or pseudo-differential operation. The full-scale analog input range is determined by the internal reference or by an externally applied reference voltage ranging from 1V to VDD. The MAX11601/MAX11603/MAX11605 feature a 2.048V internal reference and the MAX11600/MAX11602/MAX11604 feature a 4.096V internal reference. The MAX11600/MAX11601 are available in 8-pin SOT23 packages. The MAX11602-MAX11605 are available in 16-pin QSOP packages. The MAX11600-MAX11605 are guaranteed over the extended industrial temperature range (-40°C to +85°C). VI. Reliability Evaluation

A. Accelerated Life Test

The results of the 135°C biased (static) life test are shown in Table 1. Using these results, the Failure Rate (λ) is calculated as follows:

 $\lambda = \underbrace{1}_{\text{MTTF}} = \underbrace{1.83}_{192 \times 4340 \times 143 \times 2} \text{ (Chi square value for MTTF upper limit)} \\ (where 4340 \times 143 \times 2) \\ (where 4340 = \text{Temperature Acceleration factor assuming an activation energy of 0.8eV)} \\ \lambda = 7.69 \times 10^{-9} \\ \lambda = 7.69 \text{ F.I.T. (60\% confidence level @ 25°C)}$

The following failure rate represents data collected from Maxim's reliability monitor program. Maxim performs quarterly life test monitors on its processes. This data is published in the Reliability Report found at http://www.maxim-ic.com/qa/reliability/monitor. Cumulative monitor data for the C6Y Process results in a FIT Rate of 0.90 @ 25C and 15.55 @ 55C (0.8 eV, 60% UCL)

B. E.S.D. and Latch-Up Testing (lot E1Q1IQ002C, D/C 0913)

The AC32-1 die type has been found to have all pins able to withstand a transient pulse of:

ESD-HBM:	+/- 2500V per JEDEC JESD22-A114
ESD-MM:	+/- 200V per JEDEC JESD22-A115

Latch-Up testing has shown that this device withstands a current of +/- 250mA and overvoltage JEDEC JESD78.
